Salus University Named a ‘2023 Great College to Work For’

Elkins Park, Pa. - Salus University is one of the best colleges in the nation to work for, according to the Great Colleges to Work For® program.

The results, released in a special insert of *The Chronicle of Higher Education*, are based on a survey of 194 colleges and universities. In all, 72 of those institutions achieved “Great Colleges to Work For” recognition for specific best practices and policies. Results are reported for small, medium, and large institutions with Salus University included among them.

Salus University was recognized in five categories this year

- Job Satisfaction & Support
- Compensation & Benefits
- Professional Development
- Mission & Pride
- Diversity, Inclusion & Belonging

Salus University was also named to the Great Colleges Honor Roll, a status granted to only 42 colleges each year that are highlighted most across the recognition categories. This is the third year Salus has made the honor roll.

“Great companies form a community around their employees, providing a common vision and support for everyone’s goals,” said Maura Keenan, vice president of Human Resources. “At the foundation of our Salus community is respect, fairness, open communication, inclusion, professional and personal engagement and innovation to mention a few. The survey results are based on a two-part assessment process: an institution questionnaire that captures employment data and workplace policies from each institution, and a survey administered to faculty, administrators, and professional

support staff. The primary factor in deciding whether an institution received recognition was the employee feedback.

The Great Colleges to Work For® program is one of the largest and most respected workplace-recognition programs in the country.
