The participant must indicate the nature of the complaint; the CE program about which the complaint is based; the date and time of the issue giving rise to the complaint; and any other pertinent information about the complaint. GISP will respond in writing to complaints within 15 business days of receipt of the complaint. GISP will make determinations regarding appropriateness of refunds based on complaints in consultation with the Salus University CE advisory group.
